Vice Speaker Isabekov recalls draft law on nationalization of the "Kumtor" gold mine

The Vice Speaker of Jogorku Kenesh, Kubanychbek Isabekov, recalled the draft law "On nationalization of "Kumtor" gold mine". This decision is related to the adoption of the Law "On ratification of the Agreements on new terms for the "Kumtor" project among the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic, "Kyrgyzaltyn" OJSC, the Canadian company "Centerra Gold, Inc.", "Kumtor Operating Company" CJSC, "Kumtor Gold Company" CJSC and the Canadian corporation "Cameco"" dated April 24, 2009, and with regard to the betterment of Kyrgyzstan's position in the "Kumtor" project. Russia's Gazprom intends to privatize oil and gas facilities in Kyrgyzstan

The Chairman of "Gazprom" OJSC Aleksei Miller and the Prime-Minister of Kyrgyzstan Igor Chudinov, at a meeting held in the headquarters of Gazprom, have reviewed the issue of developing cooperation in the oil and gas industry. Mining Legislative Changes

Decree No. 272 of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic "On emergency measures on reforming the management of mining field of the Kyrgyz Republic" dated June 12, 2009

Based on the analysis of the mining industry of the KR, which showed the low level of development of the mineral resource deposits, it was decided to introduce much needed reforms into the mining industry. One of the main goals of the reforms is to establish a system of mining laws based on the improved current legislation and developing new legal acts in the sphere of subsoil use. Moreover, through such reforms it is aimed to establish a single center on developing the mining sphere through introducing a system of "edinoe okno" in subsoil use, including the licensing, revision of projects, and monitoring and implementation of legislation. In addition, under this Order, it was decided to transform the Kyrgyz State Agency for Geology and Mineral Resources into the State Agency for Geology and Mining Industry

In realization of the Presidential Decree No. 272 the State Geology Agency has prepared and published in its website the following draft laws:

Law of the Kyrgyz Republic "On introducing amendments and addenda into the Law of the Kyrgyz Republic "Land Code of the Kyrgyz Republic"; Law of the Kyrgyz Republic "On production sharing agreements in subsoil use";

Law of the Kyrgyz Republic "On concessions"; Law of the Kyrgyz Republic "On mine concessions"; Law of the Kyrgyz Republic "On production sharing agreements";

Amendments into the Tax Code adopted by Jogorku Kenesh of the Kyrgyz Republic;

2 mountainous pasture management projects launched in Kyrgyzstan

Two mountain pasture management projects were launched in Kyrgyzstan through support of UNDP: the five year projects in Suusamyr valley and at the basin of the Jergetal and Ottuk rivers. The international organization donated 2 mln US dollars to finance and implement the projects. Decree No. 410 of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic "On introducing amendments and addenda to the Decree of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic dated December 30, 2008 No. 736 "On the measures on implementing the provision requirements of the Tax Code of the Kyrgyz Republic" dated June 25, 2009

The government of the KR adopted Decree No. 410 for the purposes of implementing Article 304 (Bonus Amount) of the Tax Code. This decision was based on the changes in price for mineral resources and processed products due to the world economic crisis. The State Agency on Geology and Mineral Resources under the Government of the KR was required to annually update the stocks and resources of deposits and the amount of bonuses under this Decree.

Decree No. 355 of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic "On approving draft agreements and contracts that are derived from the Agreement on new terms for the "Kumtor" project" dated June 5, 2009

For the purposes of further realization of the Agreement on new terms for the "Kumtor" project made among the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic, "Kyrgyzaltyn" OJSC, the Canadian company "Centerra Gold, Inc.", "Kumtor Operating Company" CJSC, "Kumtor Gold Company" CJSC and the Canadian corporation "Cameco"" dated April 24, 2009, the Government approved a number of agreements that are derived from the "Kumtor" project.

Decree No. 374 of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic "On changing the border of the State national park "Chon-Kemin" dated June 13, 2009.

For the purposes of attracting investment in mining industry and developing geological exploration and development works in the Kemin district of the Chui oblast, the Government of the KR decided to remove the land plots "Ak-Tyuz" and "Oktorkoi" and other land from the national park's land. leading law firms worldwide. *Please follow the web-site for further information:* <u>http://www.k-a.kg/uploads/Mining2009.pdf</u>
