On movement of employees

In order to ensure uninterrupted activities of Bishkek in accordance with Article 17 of the Constitutional Law of the Kyrgyz Republic on "State of Emergency", **I order:**

1. To ensure unhindered movement from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. for employees of companies and organizations engaged in activities specified in Annex hereto.
2. To ensure:
 - movement of employees specified in paragraph 1 of this Order, holding certificates of employment, traveling along a predetermined route and strictly by car sponsored by companies or organizations, including the outsourced ones;
 - movement of drivers holding certificates of employment, trip tickets, vehicle registration certificates, driver license, and passengers (employees) list.
3. To authorize the Mayor of Bishkek (Surakmatov A.E.) and Head of Bishkek Department of Internal Affairs (Djumagaziev K.S.) to take all necessary measures aiming at the effective implementation of this Order.
4. Control and responsibility for compliance with this order rests with me.

**LIST
OF TYPES OF PERMITTED BUSINESS ACTIVITIES
DURING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY**

1. Enterprises engaged in the production, processing, shipment and sale of:
 - 1.1. agricultural products, food, beverage and in-kind or processed food products, including co-productions (production of packing, tanks, feeding stuff, etc.);
 - 1.2. medicines, medical supplies and products (including personal protection equipment, medical masks and robes);
 - 1.3. oil and lubricants and gas cylinders.
2. All kind of services of the Housing and Public Utilities (water, sewer, gas, electricity, heating, removal and disposal of garbage).
3. Disinfection services.
4. Medical and health facilities.
5. Commercial banks.

To recommend the National Bank of the Kyrgyz republic to suspend activities of microfinance organizations and exchange bureaus.

6. Private security organizations related to the abovementioned organizations.
7. Customs brokers.
8. Kyrgyz Post Office.
9. Laboratories.

Remark:

The activities of the abovementioned organizations are allowed if they ensure 5 sq.m. per 1 (one) person in service area and compulsory distance of at least 1,5 meters between clients and customers.
